PRIMARY MODEL: DEAD SEA SCROLL COMMUNITY (1QS, 4Q275) SUPPLEMENTAL MODEL: DAVIDIC-LEVITICAL HOME SCHOOL PATTERN

PHASE 1: YELADIM (Ages 5-12) — "Foundations of the Covenant"

Curriculum Duration: 7 years (divided into seasonal cycles, Exodus 13:10)

Primary Scrolls: 1QS Manual of Discipline, 4Q275 Entry into the Covenant

Weekly Format:

- Day 1 (Yom Rishon): Aleph-Bet (Paleo-Hebrew tracing drills)
- Day 2: Torah Portion Recitation (Genesis 1; Exodus 20)
- Day 3: Shema Practice + Commandment Copying (Deut. 6:4–9)
- Day 4: Psalms & Proverbs Song (Psalms 1; Prov. 1:7)
- Day 5: Visual Command Drill (10 Words, Leviticus 19 pictograms)

Key Learning Goals:

- Recite Shema & 10 Commandments fluently
- Write and trace Paleo-Hebrew alphabet
- Copy Torah words (e.g., YAHUAH, Torah, Yisra'el)
- Sing 2+ Covenant songs (Exodus 15; Deut. 32)

PHASE 2: NE'ARIM (Ages 12-20) — "Discipline of the Set-Apart"

Primary Scrolls: 4Q394–399 (MMT), 4Q279 (Four Classes of Community), Damascus Document (CD)

Weekly Format:

- Day 1: Law of Separation (Purity Code Studies)
- Day 2: Scroll Copying (Leviticus 11; 4Q279 Halakhic notes)
- Day 3: Peer Discussion on Covenant Roles (1QS 5:1–12)
- Day 4: Public Reading Training (Deut. 31:10-13)
- Day 5: Problem-Solving w/ Proverbs & Sirach (2Q18)

Key Learning Goals:

- Understand community roles (priest, judge, elder, scribe)
- Copy full chapters of Torah accurately
- Debate purity and justice laws
- · Lead public Scripture readings and give summaries

PHASE 3: BANIM haBRIT (Ages 20+) — "Guardians of Wisdom"

Primary Scrolls: 11QT (Temple Scroll), 1QM (War Scroll), 4Q400–403 (Sabbath Songs), Wisdom Texts (4Q415–418)

Weekly Format:

- Day 1: Temple Protocols & Sanctuary Law (Exodus 25-40; 11QT)
- Day 2: Strategy & Warfare of Light vs Darkness (1QM)
- Day 3: Sabbath Songs Study (4Q403)
- Day 4: Prophecy Study: Isaiah & Habakkuk (1QIsa; 1QpHab)
- Day 5: Leadership Case Study: David, Hezekiah, Ezra

Key Learning Goals:

- Draft vision-based scrolls or commentaries
- Train younger students in Aleph-Bet and Torah
- · Understand Temple design, timing, and festivals
- Practice discerning false doctrine vs true Torah
